WASHINGTON STATE over Boise State 10:30 P.M. ET

Washington State has struggled mightily during the Mike Leach Era in



the early stages of the season. Over the last 5 years, the Cougars have gone just 2-5 in the first two weeks of

the season, including unforgivable losses to the likes of Eastern Washington, Portland State and Rutgers. Because of that, we have been told that Leach put a huge emphasis on getting off to a better start this season and not suffering similar early-season defeats, so we expect a fully focused effort here from Washington State, which is also in a revenge spot after falling behind 14-0 and eventually dropping a 31-28 decision on Boise State's blue turf last year in Week 2. The Broncos return just four starters on defense, so you can bet that Leach will have QB Luke Faulk

throwing deep into the fourth quarter and help him start to build his case for a Heisman Trophy with some huge numbers. The Cougars are 10-6 ATS the last four years as a home chalk and Boise rarely goes on the road out of conference to play a team of this caliber on their home field. A primed and focused Washington State comes out on all cylinders and has too much for a Boise State that is in decline. 45-20

WEST VA. over E. Carolina

We predict a down year for the Mountaineers, but this is a game where head coach Dana Holgorsen knows he has to win impressively in front of the home crowd. Coming in off an opener vs. Virginia Tech, the WVU offense will find the going much easier here against a depleted ECU stop unit. WVU is 18-3 in the series and 17-1 in home openers, including an average margin of victory of 30 ppg the last 13 seasons. 34-6



N.M. State over N. Mexico

Former Notre Dame head coach Bob Davie has done great things since taking over the Lobo program, except against in-state rival New Mexico State. The Aggies have covered three straight in his heated annual game, including a wild 32-31 victory last season. With nine starters back on defense and the addition of 7 JUCOS, the Aggies will be more than ready for New Mexico's runheavy attack. Take the points. 31-27



WAKE FOREST over B.C.

BC head coach Steve Addazio is one of Harry Bondi's five "College Coaches on the Hot Seat" this season (see page 4 of this issue), and after another loss to the Demon Deacons, the seat gets even hotter. Unlike BC, Wake has improved each season under head man Dave Clawson, including a 4-1 ATS record as an away dog last year. Deacons have too much firepower for the offensively challenged Eagles. 28-14

JACKSONVILLE (+5) over Houston 1 P.M. EST

The Jaguars struggled to another losing season in 2016, going just 3-13,



but you've got to give them credit for not standing put. Not only did they hire a new head coach in Doug

Marrone and go for a "sexy" first-round draft pick by selecting LSU running back Leonard Fournette with the No. 4 pick, but they also went out and spent \$173

million in free agency, the most of any other team in the league. While we expect this offense to struggle until they finally unload Blake Bortles, the defense will once again be very good in 2017. Believe it or not, the Jags had one of the best scoring defenses in the NFL in the second half of last year. That has to concern Houston head coach Bill O'Brien, whose starting quarterback Tom Savage won the job by default

over rookie Deshaun Watson. In addition to a journeyman QB, the Texans running game was also a disaster last year, ranking as the fifth-worst in the league by our advanced metrics. So we'll gladly take the points in Week 1 with an underrated Jacksonville defense going head-to-head with a Texans offense that will struggle again in 2017, especially during the early stages of the season with Tom Savage at OB. 23-17

MIAMI (-1) over Tampa Bay

No, we're not one of the very few people in the Jay Cutler Fan Club. But the fact is that this was a decent signing for the Dolphins and the former Bears sourball isn't that much of a drop off from Ryan Tannehill. Meanwhile, we think Tampa is one of the more overrated teams in the NFL. Many have them as a "sleeper" to win their division, so much so that the price here has dropped to a near pick'em. Fins win. 28-17



UNDER 47 POINTS - Browns at Steelers

The average over/under for Pittsburgh regular season games over the last two years has been 47 and, as a result, the Steelers have gone under in 20 of the 32 games (63%) played during that time span. It appears the oddsmaker has not caught on, so we'll just keep cashing tickets on the under, especially when the Pitt "D" gets to face a team and a QB as inept as the Browns and rookie QB DeShone Kizer.
