MICHIGAN: Most publications pick the Wolverines to win the Big 10, but we like Ohio State to crush Michigan's hopes for an undefeated season and National Championship on November 26. But make no mistake about it, the Wolves are loaded with one of the nation's best defenses and 8 returning starters.

SAN DIEGO STATE: The Aztecs have a top five defensive unit that led the way to a Mountain West Championship last year and will do it again in 2016. Offensively, they return 7 starters led by All American running back Donnel Pumphrey. They could be favored in every game this year.

13 BAYOR

BAYLOR: The Bears have a ton of talent, but how do they respond to their new Head Coach, Jim Grobe, and the sexual scandal that continues to rock the campus. The schedule sets up nicely to get off to a fast start, but a hellish five-game finish features games vs. Kansas State, TCU, Oklahoma, Texas and West Va.

IOWA: The Hawkeyes return a veteran QB, CJ Beathard, that has played in 28 games over the last three years, a solid running back in LeShun Danniels, and excellent WR corps as well as a defense that will be one of the nation's best. They miss Ohio State and Michigan State, so we'll call for a 10-2 finish.

USC: The Trojans have the toughest schedule in the country, but return 10 starters on what will be one of the nation's top offenses and a solid defense with the best secondary in the college game. Everyone else loves UCLA, but we think USC wins the Battle of LA and the Pac-12 South title!

FLORIDA: Head Coach Jim McElwain led the Gators to a 10-4 season in 2015 despite having one of the worst offenses in the nation. This year the offense improves, led by QB Luke DelRio, Jack's kid. He will throw to some talented receivers while the defense is top-notch. Schedule is brutal, but we still see 10-2.

MIAMI: Mark Richt inherits a very good squad at his alma mater. 

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2016 College Football Preview Notes

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There is optimism in Nebraska as Mike Riley begins his second season. Sixteen starters return, led by quarterback Tommy Armstrong, who threw for 3,030 yards and 22 touchdowns last season, but he must cut down on his interceptions after throwing 16 last season. Husker's leading rusher Terrell **Newby** also returns, as does No. 1 receiver Jordan Westerkamp. Nebraska's schedule sets up nice as the Huskers avoid Michigan State and Michigan. They must travel to Iowa, Wisconsin and Ohio State, but there's reason to believe a significant improvement can happen in Riley's second season and it better. Another 6-7 season in Lincoln gets Riley canned.

Houston had a great start to 2016 beating Florida State in the Peach Bowl last January and retaining head coach **Tom Herman**, who was pursued by several teams. If not for a loss against UConn when OB **Greg Ward Jr.** was injured, the Cougars would have been undefeated in 2015. Houston is being hailed by some as the best non-Big 5 Conference team in the country this year, but the schedule is brutal. The Cougars open with a home game against Oklahoma, followed by road tests at Cincinnati, Navy and Memphis. Many are looking for Houston to win 10 or more, but we expect the Cougars to go 8-4 in what will be Herman's last season in Houston before moving on to Texas.

Illinois Head Coach Tim Beckman was canned last year as we predicted in our 2015 Coaches on the Hot Seat. Lovie Smith, who hasn't coached the college ranks in
