# BONDI'S BEST BETS

## **CALIFORNIA (-9.5) over Oregon State 4 P.M. ET**

Not afraid to lay the lumber with Cal today considering its defense has been stout, allowing only 12.7 points per game, which ranks 9th nationally. Those numbers are even more impressive when you consider the gauntlet the Bears have been through the last four games, taking on NC State, Pittsburgh,



Miami and Florida State. Look for the fast and aggressive Bears "D" to stifle Oregon State, which has been inconsistent throughout the season. Don't be fooled by the Beavers' average of 24.3 points per game. They've put up 38 points per game against the likes of Nevada, Colorado State, Purdue and Idaho State, but the offense has been limited against quality competition. Things won't be as easy as they hit the

road and take on a Cal passing game, led by QB Fernando Mendoza, that will exploit Oregon State's defensive vulnerabilities. The Golden Bears have a completion rate of 66.67%, which ranks them 28th nationally. The Beavers have benefited from playing 5 of their 7 games at home this year where they are 11-5 ATS the last three seasons, but they are a different team on the road. The Bears maul the Beavers. **41-17**

### ★ **NO. TEXAS +8 v. Tulane**

We'll gladly take the points with the home dog today. The Mean Green boast a potent offense, averaging 40.8 ppg, and is quite balanced with 348.6 passing yards and 163.2 rushing yards ppg. North Texas has been a solid bet in conference play the last 4 seasons, going 21-7 ATS and their loss to Memphis last week puts them in a great spot as head coach Eric Morris is 6-2 ATS following a loss. Home dog! **41-37**

### ★ **WYOMING -2 v. Utah St.**

The numbers for the Utah St. "D" are scary bad, allowing 48 ppg and 526 yards of offense per game, which rank last in the nation, and they've been especially poor vs. the run, giving up 6 yards per carry. Those numbers are even more scary when you consider they've played just the 93rd most difficult schedule to date. The Cowboys will dominate in the trenches and beat Utah State for a 3rd straight year. It's **34-20**

### ★ **HAWAII -1 v. Nevada**

Making the trip across the Pacific to play the Rainbows is a difficult task. Hawaii is 16-8 ATS on its home field since 2021. As usual, Hawaii's offensive strength is its passing game. QB Brayden Schager has thrown for 1,788 yards and 13 TDs and will have his way vs. Nevada's defense, which gives up 28.3 ppg. The Rainbows have won 4 of the last 5 meetings in this series and they get another "W" here at home. **31-21**

## **GREEN BAY (-4.5) over Jacksonville 1 P.M. ET**

We cashed a winning ticket with the Jaguars last week when they righted the ship and saved head coach Doug Pederson's job for one more week with a 32-16 win over the lowly Patriots in London, but consider that win like a big Band Aid over a huge wound. This is still a team with many problems, first and foremost a sieve-like



defense that ranks third-worst in the league, allowing 27.7 ppg. In the four games leading up to the win over New England, the Jags allowed 35 points per game and that's what we expect the Pack to do this week. Led by QB Jordan Love, Green Bay is averaging 383.1 yards per game, which ranks them sixth in the league. Last week's two-point win over the Texans was misleading as the Packers dominated the game and it

would have been a blowout if not for Green Bay turning it over four times. On the other side of the ball, the Packers "D" has a knack for creating turnovers, ranking third in INTs this season, so expect Jags QB Trevor Lawrence to take another step back. The Jags have the worst home field "advantage" in the league and will be a bit gassed after spending the last two weeks in London. Lay the road chalk. Pack rolls. **31-17**

### ★ **CAROLINA (+9) over Denver**

The Broncos got our week off to a profitable start last Thursday when we used them in an easy win over the Saints but the oddsmakers have overreacted to that win and the Panthers' horrible loss to Washington. We still rank the Broncos as a well-below average team. They caught the Saints missing numerous starters and there's no way they should be laying this number, even to the lowly Panthers. It's **24-21**

### ★ **UNDER 42 POINTS - Jets at Patriots**

The last four meetings between these two AFC East rivals have averaged a paltry 21.5 points per game, so this number is way too high, especially when you consider just how bad this New England offense is. The Pats have yet to score more than 21 points in a single game this season, and they have been held to 16 points or less in four out of seven games while going under in all three home games. **UNDER**
